I have been working for the European Commission as the Economic & Trade Affairs Manager (Local Agent) in the Tel Aviv Delegation **for 15 years**. During most of this period I have served as the Staff Representative of the Delegation.

As staff representative I have dedicated a lot of time and effort to ensuring that local staff rights are exercised properly, defending local staff who had disagreements with the management and fighting the endless war of salary

reviews on an annual basis. In one case, I did not hesitate to approach the European Parliament, in order to press the Commission to adhere to its own rules regarding salary surveys.
